## **Antillean Marine Contributes to Relief Efforts for Haitian Victims of Hurricane Matthew**

Miami, Florida -- Miami based Antillean Marine Shipping Corp. has donated five containers to various organizations in order to help provide relief to Haiti - one of the main countries it serves - which has been significantly impacted by Hurricane Matthew.

Antillean partnered with The City of North Miami and The North Miami Police Dept. in a campaign to collect supplies to support Pesimal, Cayes Haiti. The shipping company spotted two 45 foot containers at the City of North Miami's Motor Pool facility on Friday Oct. 14 as donations. The containers will remain onsite until they are filled with donations made by the community, then sent to Haiti. On that same day, Antillean also shipped three 40 foot containers for the Evangelical Baptist Mission of South Haiti and is currently working on 40 foot containers for Food for the Poor.

"We are honored to be able to help the Haitian community in any way that we can," said Sara C. Babun, President and CEO of Antillean Marine. "Since day one we are committed to helping those that have been affected by catastrophes. Especially the countries we service."
